at Morphettville

**T**his month's successful nomination for Owner of the Month was received from Alistair McFarlane who nominated Peter Katanis for his horses Into the Mist, Miss Adele and Exciting Prospect all winners in September.

Last Wednesday (September 9th) he kicked off when Into the Mist, which he bred and races, won race 6 at Morphettville Parks by 3 lengths.

Saturday (September 12th) on the Morphettville track, Miss Adele, named after his lovely daughter and bred by a much better looking bloke, came from last and weaved her way through the field to snatch victory in the Hyland Race Colours Handicap by a long head.

To top it off on that Sunday Exciting Prospect won its second race in Singapore for Peter.

Miss Adele who was of course bred by Alistair is by Bel Esprit from Villa Lante (Filante) who is also the dam of Stella Lante and Stravinsky Code. Exciting Prospect is by Distorted Humour from Butters (El Prado).

We wish Peter continued success with his racing ventures.

## SAROA APPRENTICE AWARD

When this article goes to press the Apprentice Academy Awards night will have taken place and the SAROA Apprentice Award will have gone to Caitlin Jones. Caitlin was nominated by our member Ian Perryman who had this to say about Caitlin:

As a SAROA member, I nominate apprentice rider Caitlin Jones for the SAROA Apprentice Award.

Caitlin has ridden several of the horses which I part own including Hioctdane and The Clash and has adhered well to the trainers instructions on each occasion. (In fact Caitlin rode Hioctdane to a win back in August)

Prior to, and following the race, when addressing the owners, she has on each occasion been able to give an accurate appraisal of the run, and to discuss the positives /negatives of the horse's performance, but most importantly she has done this while looking you (the owner) in the eye.

During my 30+ years of racing horses, I have not always enjoyed talking to jockeys (some senior/some apprentices) who look at their boots while in discussion with the owners.

Most importantly, Caitlin does her "home-work" thoroughly on each ride and fully understands the pedigree of the horse she is about to ride.

The success which Caitlin is currently

experiencing comes as no surprise to me. She seems a very sensible young woman with a real desire to succeed in our industry.

I have no hesitation in nominating Caitlin Jones for the SAROA Apprentice Award.

SAROA is more than happy to endorse Ian's comments about Caitlin and we add our congratulations to her on being selected as the winner of our award. Caitlin, as a heavy weight apprentice, is quite restricted in the number of rides that she can accept and as such she has done remarkably well in a short time as an apprentice after being enticed to South Australia from the Victorian Picnic race circuit. At the time of writing Caitlin had recorded 12 metropolitan wins and 20 on the provincial circuit with a further 6 on the country tracks this season.

Those who attended our Horses' Birthday lunch this year will be aware that Caitlin was one of our guest speakers and that she performed extremely well when interviewed by Terry McAuliffe.
