

Raise A Dream wins
at Oakbank

Our Owner of the Month for April went to Kevin and June Pascoe for their horse Raise a Dream, here's what Kevin had to say about their horse:

"This five year old mare returned from a 5 month spell running mid field in her return race. She then went to Oakbank on Easter Monday and ran in a 1400m race on a heavy track with a heavy down pour of rain during the race. Having started from barrier 7 she crossed the field & led from this barrier from start to finish.

This has added to a race record of nine wins in 35 starts & was her first Metro win. The mare then went to Murray Bridge in a 1400m heat of the Sprint Series & again led all the way for her 10th win in 36 starts. (She has racked up five wins at Murray Bridge, her home track & she has been ridden for 5 wins by Jason Holder). This allowed her a start in the final of a \$100,000 race at Morphettville in May.

The mare is out of Raise a Vain by the Champion Miler Falvelon & is a half sister to Raise a Heart (who won 2 races from 8 starts before injury finished his racing career). The owners of this mare are Kevin & June Pascoe & Ivan & Rhonda Brook, as well as their daughters Julie Ann Grillett & Teena Glastonbury. This group of people have raced a number of horses with success over the past six years. Kevin & June also have other horses that they have bred including Halayr Jet (now back in work).

The trainer of these horses, Grant Young (former jockey), has done a great job breaking in & educating these horses to win races. We also thank Jason Holder for his efforts in winning races on all of our horses. Without a good team of people around a racing stable it is hard to be competitive. As hobby owners it allows us to enjoy the sport of horse racing."
